This Program of Graduate Studies (PGS form) is the formal statement of the student program requirements and represents what you need to do to complete your degree. This form must be submitted for all graduate students by the end of the first term of their program. To complete the form, you should consult with your program advisor. The Program Advisor must sign the form verifying approval of the proposed coursework prior to submission. All submitted PGS forms are then reviewed by the ECPS Graduate Coordinator whose signature indicates departmental approval of the proposed plan of study. Your PGS plan can change over time (e.g., if you decide on or change electives); changes to the PGS must be submitted in writing with approval of your Program Advisor prior to Departmental approval. As a complement to your PGS, every year you will also be asked to submit a progress report, which will include your progress and plan for meeting these requirements.
