Your PGS plan can change over time (e.g., if you decide on or change electives); changes to the PGS must be submitted in writing with approval of your Program Advisor prior to Departmental approval. As a complement to your PGS, every year you will also be asked to submit a progress report, which will include your progress and plan for meeting these requirements.
